This was the topic at a number of meetings late in December as we prepared to welcome a New Year, One Day at a Time.

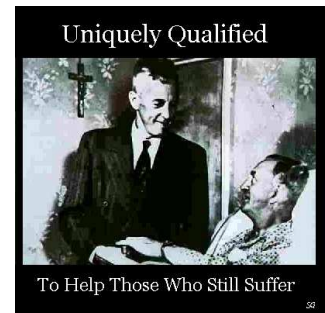
Of course, many New Year’s Resolutions were made; some broken already.
