The District's May Newsletter reported on actions taken and reports given at the last [May 4th] District meeting.

Treasurer's reports for April and May were approved at that meeting and copies included in our May Newsletter. There was no June District meeting so there are no meeting results to report, **This does, however, give us a chance to share information on several AA items of significance.**

June and July treasurer's reports will be reviewed at the July 6th meeting and copies printed in our July Newsletter.

DISTRICT 13 AA MEETING LISTS are printed three times each year, now showing over 70 meetings each week. If your Group still needs copies of the current list, contact Tom B or John D [see page 3 for phone & e-mail.

Records Keeper Paul G asks all Groups to inform him of any changes in Group meeting locations, days or times and GSR/contact information as soon as possible so they can be included in District, Area and GSO records.

District 13 meeting lists also are regularly provided at request of other entities, for example, Glens Falls Hospital, Hudson Headwaters Health Network, North Country Ministry and several Halfway Houses, just to name a few.

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The following information is from the May 4th District 13 Meeting and many new items since then:

Our new **District 13 DCM, Lou H**, chaired the 5/4 meeting. He welcomed all present and thanked Tom B who just completed his two-year service term as District 13 DCM.

Tom B. wasted no time in offering continued service to our District. At the 5/4 meeting, **Tom was elected District Treasurer**. Congratulations, Tom, and thank you for your dedicated service to AA.

Don B has been coordinating much of our District's Corrections efforts **AND** has been taking many meetings into the two NY State correctional facilities in Comstock. Don has informed DCM Lou H that other serious demands on his time mean Don has stopped bringing those AA meetings into Comstock. We thank Don for his dedicated service over a long time and now we have a desperate need for members to fill Don's shoes. Please consider helping out – even if just once a month!

We also are grateful to Faye M. who is handling the Washington County Correctional meetings by herself!

Outgoing **Treatment Chair, Kevin A**, reported on multiple meetings being covered in Treatment Facilities and that AA literature and AA literature racks are placed in several of these locations [and refilled with AA literature because of Group contributions to the District].

The May 4th Treasurer's Report listed Groups that have made recent contributions to the District. **We are deeply grateful to these Groups and AA members** whose assistance is so vital to District service work such as **the 24-hour Telephone Hotline**. The July 6th Treasurer's Report will acknowledge contributions received since the May 4th Report. Because of these contributions, the District was able to vote for and approve this year's mailing of District meeting lists to hotels and motels at a cost of up to \$44 for postage and printing of approx. 360 extra meeting lists. **The meeting lists were mailed to over 100 hotels and motels on May 24th and Tom B. hand delivered meeting lists to many others in the Lake George area.**

- We also discussed at the meeting, the vacant, or soon to be vacant District 13 positions [members whose terms have ended]. **Please consider taking one of the following service positions:**

- Alternate DCM; Committee Chairs for: BTG; Treatment; Corrections; Special Needs; Grapevine & Archives. Also, John D's two year term as Committee Chair for Cooperation with the Professional Community (CPC) and Public Information (PI) has ended so **we are looking for a new CPC/PI Chair as well. How about you?**

- One member, Jenny H, expressed an interest in the **Archives** position at the 5/4 District meeting. Jenny met with the past Archives Chair, Tim C. and retrieved District 13 Archives from him for use by the new Chairperson. **The District thanks Tim for his past service as Archives Chair and thanks Jenny for her new District 13 Archives efforts.** Jenny may have Archives information for us at the July 6th District meeting.

- Newsletter Editor, Larry T, pointed out that his two-year term also has ended and a replacement is needed. Hello out there! Who wants to be our new District 13 Newsletter Editor?

- DCM Lou H represented District 13 at the May 15th HMB Area 48 Assembly in Amsterdam and the June 18th Area 48 Fellowship Day in Lake George. At the 5/15 event, Area 48 Delegate Deb D. gave an inspiring and thorough 'report back' on that General Service Conference. At the 6/18 event, Committee Roundtables reviewed AA service issues identified at last January's Inventory Day as needing attention and discussed the progress [or lack of progress] made on these issues since January. **We will have reports on these 5/15 and 6/18 events at the next District meeting on July 6th.**

- District 13 keeps a very low 'Prudent Reserve' of funds - \$250, which barely covers two months of District expenses including for the 24 hour/7 days per week **Telephone Hotline**. District members discussed this on 5/4 and further discussion will occur on the process for voting on expenditures when funds exceed \$250. This discussion also will include possible District contributions to Area 48 and the GSO – not done in quite a while.
